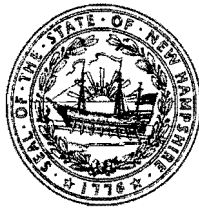

Re: Inapplicability of RSA 15-A to Legislative Employees


Dear Attorney Kennedy:

I recently received a letter from Attorney General Ayotte dated January 3, 2007, advising me that, as a department head, I was obligated to file with the Secretary of State's Office certain disclosure forms and an organizational chart as provided by RSA 15-A. My review of the statute and its applicable provisions, leads me to believe that I am excluded from the statute's requirements.

As the Legislative Budget Assistant, I am an employee of the legislative branch. Revised Statutes Annotated 15-A:2, I, which defines "agency" for the purposes of the statute, expressly states that it applies only to the executive branch. Moreover, RSA 15-A:2, II, which defines "agency head," specifically excludes those working in the "legislative and judicial branches of government." See RSA 5-A:2, II (2006 Supp.). Accordingly, since the clear language of the statute provides that it applies only to the executive branch in one provision, and since employees of the legislative branch are also expressly excluded from the statute's requirements in another, my position falls outside the purview of the statute. Consequently, I am not required to file either the disclosure form or the organizational chart described in Attorney General Ayotte's recent letter.
