
Enclosed please find my 2010 Statement of Financial Interests - - RSA 15-A form, which I am filing in connection with my position as a member of the New Hampshire Judicial Council and as a member of the Department of Corrections Statewide Citizens Advisory Board.

As I indicated to you in my letters accompanying the filing of similar forms for the year 2009, I wish to note that I and/or my spouse are the holders of small amounts of stock (generally less than 200 shares in any one company) in various corporations, such as General Electric, Exxon Mobil, Pfizer, Bank of America, United Health Group, Verizon, etc. I am unaware of whether any of such corporations may have licensing, regulatory or legislative matters pending in New Hampshire that could potentially affect their business and, therefore, indirectly have some potential beneficial or detrimental affect on myself or my spouse as shareholders. I have previously discussed with Deputy Attorney General Orville Fitch whether these holdings would qualify as "special interests" within the meaning of RSA 15-A, and have been informed that the affect of any potential governmental action on such holdings is so attenuated as to not fall within the statutory definition of "special interest." Accordingly, I have not included these holdings in completing the enclosed form.
