STACEY TAKES HELM OF COUNTY ORGANIZATION

Dixville Notch, Coos County, NH: Cathy Ann Stacey, Rockingham County's elected Register of Deeds, was elected President of the New Hampshire Association of Counties during the Association's annual meeting on October 5, 2005. Stacey who has been Register of Deeds since 1994 has served on the county government organization's board since 1997 and will serve as the Association President until October 2007.

Stacey said, "County governments provide a valuable set of services to the citizens of New Hampshire, and making sure that these services are efficiently and wisely delivered is my top priority. This means working with the state government to establish a positive working relationship, valuing our county professionals, and remembering that the taxpayers need an accountable and efficient system." Stacey added, "It is my hope that during my term of office, the Association through its members, reaches out to its constituents and educates them on the vital role county government serves on a daily basis throughout this state."

Stacey was born in and continues to reside in Salem, NH. She graduated from St. Anselm College and in 2004 earned a Juris Doctor degree from Massachusetts School of Law.

In addition to electing Stacey President, the Association selected Hillsborough County Commissioner Toni Pappas as President-Elect, Coos County Commissioner Burnham "Bing"

Judd as 1st Vice President, Rockingham County Commissioner Katharin “Kate” Pratt as 2nd Vice President, and Grafton County Commissioner William Gabler as the Association’s Clerk. In addition, Suzanne Collins, Coos County Administrator, was elected Treasurer. Belknap County Commissioner Christopher Boothby served as President of the Association from 2003 through 2005 and will serve on the Board in his capacity as Immediate Past President.
