The Interparliamentary Conference on Human Rights and Religious Freedom is composed of members of national and supranational parliaments from around the globe. IPC allows members of parliaments to meet and address the issues of human rights and freedom of conscience with common understanding and background as parliamentarians. The Conference and its members examine, monitor, and act in coordination as a body and in their respective parliaments to address either human rights/freedom of conscience situations in specific countries or territories or on major phenomena of human rights/freedom of conscience violations worldwide in thematic processes. The main themes addressed by the Interparliamentary Conference on Human Rights and Religious Freedom focus on the question of the violation of human rights and fundamental freedoms – particularly freedom of religion, belief, and conscience – in any part of the world. Among these are freedom of expression, religious intolerance, the human rights of minorities and displaced persons, trafficking in persons, and the general promotion and protection of human rights.
