Senator Joseph Kenney of Wakefield was awarded "State Senator of the Year" and Representative Cindy Rosenwald of Nashua, "State Representative of the Year," at the Annual Meeting of the New Hampshire Medical Society on Saturday, Oct. 28 in North Conway. Both legislators were honored for their "...leadership and commitment to the New Hampshire Medical Society's mission for the betterment of public health."

Medical Society President, Dr. Marc Sadowsky, read resolutions highlighting Senator Kenney's past efforts on behalf of patients and our health care system, including increased penalties for sexual predators, bike helmets for children, insurance coverage for bone marrow testing, passage of Michelle's Law, liability reform legislation and prescription drug privacy. Representative Rosenwald's resolution recognized her work on increasing penalties for makers and sellers of methamphetamine, support for a statewide smoking ban in bars and restaurants, improvements to the living will law, medical liability reform and for her sponsorship of the new prescription drug privacy act.
