and that your equipment needs include **an easel with paper**

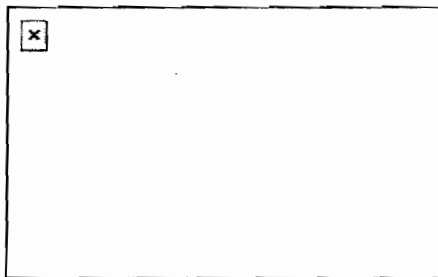

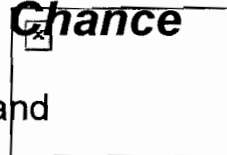
