The Steering Committee of the Reforming States Group (RSG), in collaboration with the Milbank Memorial Fund, invites you to participate in the eastern regional meeting of the RSG, which will be held at the Jurys Hotel in Washington, DC, on October 10-12, 2007.

The RSG is a voluntary association of leaders in health policy in the legislative and executive branches of government from the 50 states, several Canadian provinces, and more recently, England, Scotland, and Australia.

The purpose of the meeting is for leaders in health policy in the states and provinces to share recent experiences and to identify current issues likely to be debated during the 2008 legislative session. In addition, this will be an opportunity to reflect on the evolving relationship between state and federal authority in areas of access, expansion of coverage, and accountability. We expect that approximately 35 senior state officials will participate in this meeting.

The discussion among participants will focus on identifying gaps in the oversight and delivery of health services, as well as appropriate approaches that will close those gaps. Areas of discussion at recent regional meetings have included: efforts to expand health care access; Medicaid reforms; long-term care oversight and financing; health quality and system reform; oral health; and mental health. In all instances, these discussions will consider the federal-state/provincial relationships that are at the core of policy debates.


