As part of the Data Quality Campaign's (DQC) efforts to provide a national forum for conversations about the power of longitudinal across the P-20 spectrum, this Regional Meeting is a joint partnership between the DQC and the New England Board of Higher Education (NEBHE). The meeting will focus on the need to align P-12 and postsecondary data systems to better inform educators and policymakers with high-quality student-level longitudinal data.
