



### From Inspiration to Innovation...

Almost a decade ago, experts converged for a landmark meeting at Jackson Hole, WY, to address the critical need for collaboration to improve services to families experiencing both domestic violence and child abuse. That national summit touched off a revolution that has changed the way communities across the nation address the co-occurrence of domestic violence and child abuse.

The revolution will continue this summer when the National Council of Juvenile and Family Court Judges and the Family Violence Prevention Fund hold the "next" national summit on the co-occurrence of domestic violence and child abuse on June 2-4, 2009, also at Jackson Hole.

National experts will discuss the latest research and developments on the topic of co-occurrence and give participants tools to improve cross-system collaboration in the delivery of services to victims of domestic violence and child abuse.

### Who Should Attend?

This summit is open to domestic violence and child advocates, judges and court personnel, attorneys, child welfare workers, researchers, community collaborators, and any other professions working on domestic violence and child abuse issues. **Communities are encouraged to bring teams that represent the primary systems (child welfare, courts/legal, domestic violence) who are currently collaborating or wish to collaborate on interventions and services.** Priority is given to Office on Violence Against Women (OVW) grantees.

This summit will foster leadership development, focus attention on key overlap issues, enhance participants' ability to identify

needs, and introduce new policies and practices that facilitate reform, encourage peer-to-peer support, and keep vibrant the current network of communities. This will be done in a variety of ways:

- Interactive educational sessions and workshops
- Poster sessions and think tanks
- Keynote speakers
- Cross-system and peer-to-peer dialogues

## Topics

Areas to be covered at this summit may include:

- On-the-ground project leadership
- Engaging fathers
- Innovative approaches to collaboration
- Safety planning for intact families
- Connecting juvenile justice and child welfare
- Cultural relevancy
- Confidentiality and information sharing
- Public policy and legal issues

The summit begins at 8:00 a.m. June 2 and ends at 12:30 p.m. on June 4. The participant fee for this summit is \$275.
