Health Information Technology: Saving Lives, Reducing Costs and Creating Jobs

Purpose of Travel

This conference will assist William Baggeroer to come together with other states' and national leaders to discuss health information technology and health information exchange. The program will also highlight business opportunities in this field, as we take on one of the biggest challenges of our time: meaningfully using HIT and HIE to improve patient care and expand the economy. Conference participants including, Governors, HIT Coordinators, Secretaries of Health and Human Services, Medicaid Commissioners, and key state legislators from across the US, have been invited to participate in this event. Thursday afternoon will feature plenary keynotes from Sec. Sebelius and Dr. Blumenthal with breakout sessions for the states to get together with other states to explore regional collaborations followed by a reception. Friday morning will begin with a plenary presentation involving senior government leaders, after which there will be a series of breakout sessions for state officials to share lessons learned and best practices. Panels will address a wide range of issues relating to how HIT can help states improve the quality of healthcare, lower costs, and create jobs. The conference will be held at the Westin Waterfront Hotel in Boston and will be open to the public.

Mr. Baggeroer will be driving to Boston, MA on Thursday, April 29, 2010 and returning on Friday, April 30, 2010. The MA eHealth Institute Conference runs from Thursday, April 29, 2010 through Friday, April 29, 2010. The MA eHealth Institute will be covering 100% of Mr. Baggeroer's expenses associated with the Conference. No state funds are requested. All travel expenses are fully funded by The MA eHealth Institute.
