REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the Department of Justice to enter into a sub grant with the Hillsborough County Department of Corrections (V# 177406-B003), in the amount of \$20,000, from the United States Department of Justice's Bureau of Justice Assistance FFY2012 Residential Substance Abuse Treatment grant program for residential substance abuse treatment programming from the date of Governor and Council approval through September 30, 2014. This is 100% Federal Funds.

EXPLANATION

The Residential Substance Abuse Treatment for State Prisoners (RSAT) Formula Grant Program assists states and units of local government in developing and implementing residential substance abuse treatment programs in state and local correctional and detention facilities. This grant award from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance is designed to fund residential substance abuse treatment programs for adult and juvenile state offenders. These funds support on-going projects including the Adolescent Drug and Alcohol Program at the Sununu Youth Services Center, an intensive, multi-phase substance abuse treatment program, and four jail-based substance abuse programs.


A mandatory 10 percent of the State's RSAT allocation has been passed through to county correctional facilities since 2003. The Hillsborough County Department of Corrections contracts with a licensed drug and alcohol counselor to provide counseling services, and conducts random drug testing for inmates who are identified as having substance use disorder.

In the event that federal funds become no longer available, general funds will not be requested to support this program.
