
REQUESTED ACTION

Pursuant to RSA 227-H:7, authorize the Department of Resources and Economic Development (DRED) to accept a monetary donation of \$600 from Tom Woodman of Chesterfield, NH to be deposited in the Forest Improvement Fund.

EXPLANATION

Since 1982, DRED has held a conservation easement on a property owned by Tom Woodman in the Town of Chesterfield. Mr. Woodman has proven to be a conscientious land owner and partner to the easement.
