REQUESTED ACTIONS

Authorize the Department of Justice to enter into a sub grant with the NH Coalition Against Domestic and Sexual Violence, (Vendor #155510-B001), in the amount of \$226,157 from the US Department of Justice, Office on Violence Against Women, Sexual Assault Support Program, for the purpose of providing services for victims of sexual assault in New Hampshire, from the period of Governor and Council approval through June 30, 2014. This is 100% federal funding.

EXPLANATION

The Sexual Assault Support Program (SASP) is a relatively new formula grant program from the US Department of Justice, Office on Violence Against Women and will be awarded to New Hampshire on an annual basis. These funds are the first federal funding stream solely dedicated to the provision of direct intervention and related assistance for victims of sexual assault.


The majority of these funds will be pass-thru to the NH Coalition Against Domestic and Sexual Violence (NHCADSV) as a sub grant. NHCADSV will in turn pass this funding through to twelve member agencies that will provide services to sexual assault victims on statewide bases. The goals of the program are to institute programs designed to address the lack of available direct intervention and related assistance services and the unique aspects of sexual assault trauma from which victims must heal. Services may include intervention, advocacy, support services, and related assistance to adult, youth and child victims of sexual assault.

These projects are funded one hundred percent (100%) by federal dollars. In the event that federal funds become no longer available, general funds will not be requested to support this program.
