REQUESTED ACTION

1. Authorize the Department of Transportation to enter into a contract with Connie's Septic Service, Inc. dba C.S.S.I. (Vendor 155415) of Bedford, NH on the basis of a low bid of \$817,424.87 for safety improvements at the intersection of NH 28, NH 126 and Wes Locke Road, from the date of Governor and Council approval through June 28, 2013 unless extended by the Department in accordance with the Standard Specifications. 100% Federal Funds.

2. Further authorize that a contingency in the amount of \$81,742.49 be approved for payment of latent conditions, which may appear during the construction of the project. The contingency requested is 10% of the contract amount.

EXPLANATION

This project is part of the annual Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP). The project involves widening along NH 28 to provide left and right turn lanes, and installing traffic signals at the intersection to improve safety. The Town of Barnstead worked with the Lakes Region Planning Commission on a NH 28 corridor Safety Study in 2009, and as a result this intersection was chosen for safety improvements due to the number and severity of the accidents that have occurred over time. Data showed that from 2002 to 2009 there were 18 crashes at this intersection, including 8 severe injury accidents.

The contingency amount is proposed to be 10% of the contract amount. Heavy traffic volumes in an area of known accidents along NH 28 will increase risk of overruns. Adjusting limits to offset quantity overruns is not practical.

The Contractor has been prequalified by this Department. The Contract has been approved by the Attorney General as to form and execution, and the Department has certified that the necessary funds are available. Copies of the fully executed contract are on file at the Secretary of State's Office and the Department of Administrative Service's Office, and subsequent to Governor and Council approval will be on file at the Department of Transportation.

This project funding is 90% federal funds with 10% state match. Turnpike toll credit is being utilized for match requirements, effectively using 100% federal funds.

A copy of the Tabulation of Bids received for this project is attached along with the Contract Supplemental Sheet and a map indicating the location of the project.

## **SUPPLEMENTAL PROJECT INFORMATION SHEET**

**DESCRIPTION:** The proposed project, located in the Town of Barnstead, involves safety improvements at the intersection of NH 28, NH 126 and Wes Locke Road. Roadway work associated with the project begins at a point approximately 800 feet south of the NH 28/126 intersection on US 28 and continues north, approximately 1600 feet, along NH 28 and includes approach work on NH 126 and Wes Locke Road. This project will construct a northbound right turn lane from NH 28 to NH 126, a northbound left turn lane from NH 28 to Wes Locke Road and a southbound left turn lane from NH 28 to NH 126. Widening will be required in the southeast quadrant of the intersection, on NH 28 for about 500 feet (approx. 10 feet wide). Wes Locke Road approach will be reconstructed. NH 126 approach will be reconstructed due to deficiencies in the vertical geometry and includes installation of a traffic signal at the NH 28/126 intersection.

**FEDERAL FUNDING:** 90% federal funding anticipated utilizing 10% Turnpike Toll credit match.

**CONTINGENCY:** The contingency amount is proposed to be 10% of the contract amount. Heavy traffic volumes in an area of known accidents along NH 28 will increase risk of overruns. Adjusting limits to offset quantity overruns is not practical

**PROJECT INITIATED:** Highway Safety Improvement Program

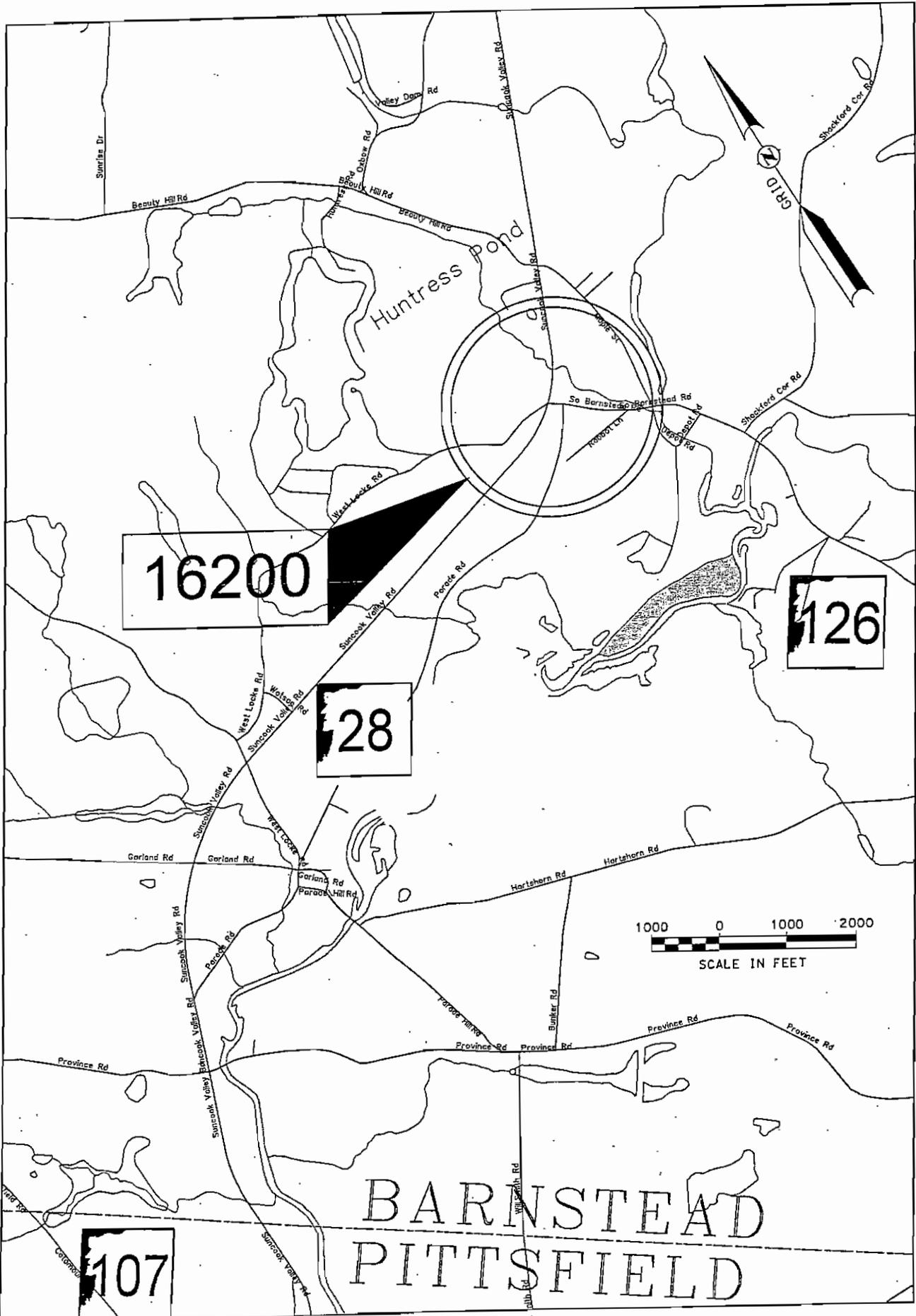
**PROJECT EXPLANATION:** Barnstead, worked with the Lakes Region Planning on the NH 28 Corridor Safety Study in 2009. In 2010 this intersection, among others, due to the number and severity of the accidents that have occurred over time, was chosen for safety improvements under the Highway Safety Improvement Program. Data showed that from 2002 to 2009 there were 18 crashes at this intersection, including 8 severe injury accidents. 100% of the crashes involved more than 1 vehicle.

### **TRAFFIC IMPLICATIONS:**

NH 28 Widening: Two-way traffic on paved lanes will be maintained at all times, except as noted below. Alternating one-way traffic will be allowed for certain construction activities (paving operations) on a single 14' minimum width lane during daylight hours with the use of uniformed officers or flaggers. In the event of excessive backup, the work will be discontinued and normal traffic patterns will be restored. Temporary traffic shifts on pavement will be used to minimize need for one-way traffic. Two-way traffic will be restored during non-work hours.

NH 126, Wes Locke Rd, Parade Rd: Two-way traffic on paved lanes will be maintained to the extent practical. Alternating one-way traffic will be allowed during non-peak hours to reconstruct roadways. Travel on gravel surfaces will be allowed; Restore paved lanes prior to weekend. Maintain Two-way traffic during non-work hours.
