REQUESTED ACTION

In accordance with RSA 4:8, authorize the Department of Administrative Services, to accept a portrait of former Governor and Senator Henry Wilder Keyes to be placed in the State House. The portrait is donated by family and friends of the late Governor and United States Senator Henry Wilder Keyes. The value of the portrait is approximately \$25,000.

EXPLANATION

Henry Wilder Keyes was the 56th Governor of New Hampshire serving from January 2, 1917 to January 6, 1919. He also served in both houses of the New Hampshire state legislature before being elected to serve as Governor of New Hampshire. Governor and Senator Keyes also served eighteen years in the United States Senate retiring on January 3, 1937. Governor and Senator Keyes lived in Haverhill, New Hampshire.
