REQUESTED ACTION

1. Authorize the Department of Transportation to enter into a contract with American Excavating Corp. (Vendor 156914) of Derry, NH on the basis of a low bid of \$594,897.72 for intersection improvements on NH 125 at Toldend Road/Greenhill Road in Barrington and modifications on NH 43 at the Exit 3 interchange with NH 101 in the Town of Candia, from the date of Governor and Council approval through August 23, 2013 unless extended by the Department in accordance with the Standard Specifications. 100% Federal Funds.

2. Further authorize that a contingency in the amount of \$29,744.89 be approved for payment of latent conditions, which may appear during the construction of the project. The contingency requested is 5% of the contract amount.

EXPLANATION

This project is part of the annual Federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) This contract includes two different HSIP projects. These two locations have been identified as having high crash rates which have collision patterns that are correctable using minor roadway and traffic control modifications. This project will improve safety at these locations.

The Barrington project will construct safety improvements at the intersection of NH 125 with Tolend Road and Greenhill Road. The work includes construction of left turn and right turn lanes and signaling the intersection. The Candia project will reduce excessive pavement width by eliminating the extended right turn lane on NH 43 eastbound at the approach to the NH 101, Exit 3 ramp and Old Candia Road intersection.

The contingency amount is proposed to be 5% of the contract amount. This is based on several factors including: both are small, short duration projects, and there is the potential need for fuel and asphalt adjustments due to the uncertainty of fuel and oil prices.

The Contractor has been prequalified by this Department. The Contract has been approved by the Attorney General as to form and execution, and the Department has certified that the necessary funds are available. Copies of the fully executed contract are on file at the Secretary of State's Office and the Department of Administrative Service's Office, and subsequent to Governor and Council approval will be on file at the Department of Transportation.

The Barrington project funding is 100% federal funds. The Candia project funding is 90% federal funds with 10% state match. Turnpike toll credit is being utilized for match requirements, effectively using 100% federal funds for the Candia project.

A copy of the Tabulation of Bids received for this project is attached along with the Contract Supplemental Sheet and a map indicating the location of the project.

SUPPLEMENTAL PROJECT INFORMATION SHEET

DESCRIPTION: This contract includes two separate Safety improvement projects in two different Southern New Hampshire Towns. Project 16201 is an Intersection improvement project on NH 125 in the Town of Barrington and Project 16413 is a pavement and lane reduction project on NH 43 in the Town of Candia.

The Barrington Intersection project will construct safety improvements at the NH 125 / Greenhill Road / Tolend Road intersection as part of the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP). The project scope includes signalizing the intersection, and constructing left turn lanes and right turn lanes on both of the NH 125 approaches. The project limits extend approximately 800' north and south of the intersection on NH 125, and extend approximately 150' from the intersection on the Greenhill Road and Tolend Road approaches.

The Candia lane/pavement reduction project is also a safety improvement project and part of the HSIP. The scope of this project is to eliminate the exclusive right turn lane on the NH 43 eastbound approach to the Exit 3 NH 101 ramp and Old Candia Road intersection. The existing lane and shoulder pavement will be eliminated to leave a 5 foot paved shoulder adjacent to the new thru/right turn lane.

FEDERAL FUNDING: Barrington 100% Federal HSIP; Candia 90% Federal HSIP, 10% NHDOT using Turnpike Toll Credits.

CONTINGENCY: The contingency amount for both projects is proposed to be 5% of the contract amount. This is based on several factors including: both are small, short duration projects, and there is the potential need for fuel and asphalt adjustments due to the uncertainty of fuel and oil prices.


PROJECT INITIATED: 2012 Federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP)

PROJECT EXPLANATION: These two locations have been identified as having high crash rates which have collision patterns that are thought to be correctable using minor roadway and traffic control modifications.


TRAFFIC IMPLICATIONS: Maintaining two-way traffic operation for both work and non-working hours during constriction, is proposed for both locations. Complete Shoulder closures with minor lane width reduction during work and non-work hours for lane widening and reduction operations will be required. Additionally short duration single lane operation with alternating traffic flow may be requested by the Contractor for some work hour operations.
