

Absentee Ballot Status Look-up & Contact Information

1) Question: Does the state website provide a voter with the ability to look up the status of his or her absentee ballot?

Answer: The Secretary of State's Registered Voter web link at <http://cfs.sos.nh.gov/app/Public/AbsenteeBallot.aspx> provides the voter's absentee ballot status, including whether the absentee ballot request has been received, whether the absentee ballot has been sent by the clerk, and whether the an absentee ballot return envelope has been received by the clerk.

2) Question: If so, what personally identifiable information is required to use this tool?

Answer: The voter's first name, last name, town or city, and date of birth.

3) Question: Who should I contact if I cannot find the absentee ballot information I am looking for?

Answer: The Secretary of State's Registered Voter web link at <http://cfs.sos.nh.gov/app/Public/AbsenteeBallot.aspx> provides contact information for your town or city clerk, who can provide information on the status of your absentee ballot request.
