**INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTERS**

1. To Vote. Completely fill in the oval  to the right of your choice. For each office vote for not more than the number of candidates stated in the sentence: "Vote for not more than \_\_\_\_." If you vote for more than the stated number of candidates, your vote for that office will not be counted.

2. To Vote a Straight Ticket.

To vote for all candidates running in the same political party (straight ticket), completely fill in the oval  to the right of the party name in the straight ticket section of the ballot. You may vote a straight ticket and also vote for individual candidates from any party. If you vote for an individual candidate, the straight ticket vote for only that office is canceled. If more than one candidate is to be elected for an office, you must mark each of your choices for that office. If you vote a straight ticket and do not completely fill in the oval  to the right of any candidate for an office, your straight ticket vote will count for that office.

3. To Vote by Write-In.

To vote for a person whose name is not printed on the ballot, write in the name of the person in the "write-in" space. Completely fill in the oval  to the right of your choice.
