REQUESTED ACTION

Pursuant to RSA 94:3, the Department of Safety, Office of the Commissioner, requests approval for an annual salary increase for Edyta Domian, Deputy Director of the Division of Administration (Position #9U652), in the amount of \$5,226.00 from a current salary of \$100,256.00 to a new annual salary of \$105,482.00, effective November 4, 2022. 30% General Funds, 26% Highway Fund, 44% Other Funds.

EXPLANATION

RSA 94:3 "Yearly Service Increases", states in part: "upon recommendation of the appointing authority, the holder of any position mentioned in RSA 94:1-a shall be entitled to an annual increase in salary amounting to 1/6 of the difference between the minimum and maximum salary for said position but in no case shall the total salary exceed the maximum as herein established".

Edyta Domian was sworn into her position as Deputy Director of the Division of Administration on October 18, 2021 and is currently paid at Labor Grade GG, Step 5. She works closely with the Director of Administration to provide leadership over six Bureaus providing critical Department of Safety functions including finance, human resources, procurement, road toll, grants management, facility management, asset management, mailroom, and plate room activities. These services have a direct impact on all DOS Divisions and their ability to execute their unique public safety missions. Deputy Director Domian has demonstrated exceptional leadership and dedication to the Division of Administration mission of making NH the safest state in the country by providing the highest quality support services to all Divisions within the Department of Safety.
